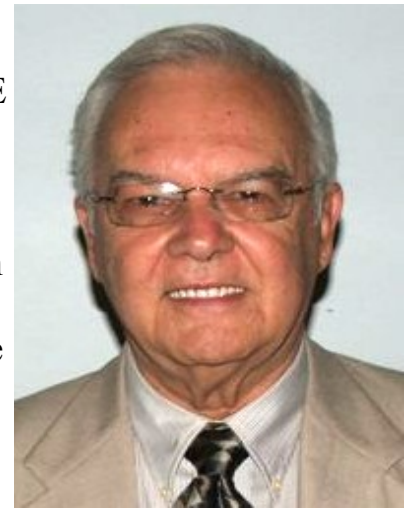
A Message from your Grand Knight
